

Camping Terms & Conditions

1. Arrival & Departure

2. Camping Pitch Regulations

- Pitches are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis and must be **booked in advance**. There are no walk-up facilities.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle, caravan, campervan or motorhome has the **parking brake / hand brake applied and left in gear**.

Camping Pitch Rules:

- Each 10m x 10m pitch can accommodate **any combination of camping units**, provided everything fits safely within the allocated space.
- Mixed camping is allowed within each zone, and pitches may include different types of setups side-by-side.
- There is only **one** caravan, campervan or motorhome allowed on each pitch.
- You are permitted to park **one** car per pitch. There is an overflow car park for any secondary vehicles.
- For health & safety, campervans, caravans, motorhomes, tents and trailer tents must be set up as illustrated below.
- Your entire setup — including all tents, vehicles, awnings, and guy ropes — must fit within your **10m x 10m** pitch.
- Each pitch can accommodate up to **six people (adults and children combined)**.
- This ticket is for **camping only**, tickets to attend the event must be purchased separately

3. General Campsite Rules

- Quiet hours: 11:00 PM – 7:00 AM.
- There is a separate quiet camping area, please see specific rules for this area below, general camping rules also apply in this area.
- There is a dedicated family area, please consider booking Family Camping if you are bringing children.
- No generators allowed.
- No sound systems permitted on site.
- No Chinese lanterns, fireworks, or drones.
- No sleeping in vehicles overnight.
- Strictly no underage drinking (under 18s).
- No selling alcohol unless by an official vendor.
- No smoking inside shared facilities, inside any structure or trailer. **Cigarette ends must be disposed of safely.**
- Glass bottles are permitted within your pitch only, but broken glass must be cleared immediately. **Walking with open glass bottles is prohibited.**
- Anyone found to break any of these rules will be evicted from site without refund.

4. Quiet Camping Rules

- Quiet Camping areas are intended for campers who prefer a more peaceful environment.
- Strict quiet hours apply between 10:00 PM and 8:00 AM - during this time, noise must be kept to an absolute minimum.
- No generators, loud music, or sound systems are permitted at any time.
- Conversations, radios, and TVs must not be audible beyond your own pitch.
- Please be considerate when returning to your pitch late at night or leaving early in the morning.
- Anti-social or noisy behaviour may result in a warning or removal from the campsite without refund.
- Children should be supervised to ensure noise levels remain respectful of others. There is a dedicated family area so please consider booking Family Camping if you are bringing children.
- The Organiser reserves the right to relocate or remove campers who breach quiet camping rules to preserve the enjoyment of all guests.

5. Fire & Safety Regulations

- **No Campfires, Wood BBQs or Open Flames** under any circumstances.
- Keep fire lanes clear at all times
- Water sources must be labelled as drinking water before use.

- Heating appliances inside tents (e.g., LPG gas rings, disposable BBQs) pose a risk of **carbon monoxide poisoning**. Use with caution.
- All pitches must be laid out as per the illustrations to ensure the safe distance between vehicles, caravans/campervans and motorhomes
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle, caravan, campervan or motorhome has the **parking brake / hand brake applied and left in gear**. Should your vehicle not be secured correctly and roll away into other pitches, you will be held liable.

Gas safety:

- Caravans & campervans **must use fitted gas bottles only** (spare bottles are not permitted).
- Campers may use **small gas stoves using a 2.2kg bottle or less**. (spare bottles are not permitted).
- No stoves allowed inside tents.

6. Vehicles & Traffic Management

- Restricted vehicle movement once on-site.
- Please make sure to follow all traffic signs both external and internal at all times.
- No vehicle movement during hours of darkness.
- Speed limit: **5mph (walking pace)**.
- Normal road regulations apply at all times.

7. Facilities & Waste Disposal

- All waste must be bagged and placed into the central waste pens provided around the site.
- Toilet waste must be emptied into designated tanks, do not empty them into toilet units.
- Respect the shared facilities and leave them clean for the next camper.
- Report any issues to the Campsite Management team

8. Alcohol Policy

- Alcohol may be consumed responsibly within your own pitch.
- Anyone found to be excessively intoxicated, causing a disturbance, or behaving anti-socially may be refused entry or removed without refund.
- No alcohol may be sold or distributed on-site except by authorised and licensed vendors.
- Under-18s are strictly prohibited from purchasing or consuming alcohol.

- The Organiser reserves the right to confiscate alcohol or refuse service to anyone in breach of these rules.
- Glass bottles are permitted within your pitch only; glass is not allowed in shared areas or walkways.

9. Illegal Substances

- The possession, use, or sale of illegal drugs or substances is strictly prohibited anywhere on the campsite or event grounds.
- Anyone found in possession of, or under the influence of, illegal substances will be removed immediately and may be reported to the police.
- The Organiser reserves the right to conduct bag or vehicle searches at the entrance or within the campsite.
- No refunds will be issued for breaches of this policy.
- The Organiser accepts no liability for any legal consequences arising from the possession or use of illegal substances on-site.

10. Wristbands & Security

- All campers must wear their issued wristbands at all times.
- Anti-social behaviour will result in ejection without refund.
- All visitors must respect the campsite, staff, and fellow campers.
- Report any issues or anti-social behaviour to the Campsite Manager or Security. You can email the campsite manager on campsite@thegamefair.org
- Campers are responsible for securing valuables, vehicles, and belongings.
- Security checks will be conducted, and any suspicious activity must be reported.

11. Cancellations, Refunds and Liability

- **All bookings are non-refundable.**
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission or to eject any person who fails to comply with these Terms & Conditions, engages in unsafe or antisocial behaviour, or poses a risk to others. No refunds will be issued in such cases.
- **All persons enter and use the campsite at their own risk.** The Organiser accepts no liability for any injury, loss, or damage to persons, vehicles, or property, except where caused directly by the Organiser's proven negligence.
- **Force Majeure:** The event may be altered, postponed, or cancelled without liability due to unforeseen circumstances beyond the Organiser's control (e.g. extreme weather, strikes, acts of God, terrorism, etc.).

12. Pets & Children

- Children/Minors (under 18) must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Well-behaved dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead when moving around and remain within your pitch.
- Owners must clean up after pets and ensure they do not cause disturbance or nuisance to others.

13. Media & Privacy

- Ticket holders consent to being included in photography, filming, or sound recordings for promotional purposes by the Organiser and its partners.
- Personal data collected during booking and attendance will be processed in accordance with the UK GDPR and the Organiser's Privacy Policy.

14. Accessibility Information

- Accessible pitches are strictly for the use of individuals who meet the eligible criteria.
- Misuse of an accessible pitch (e.g. booking without valid eligibility or providing false documentation) may result in the cancellation of your booking without refund.
