

Clay Pigeon Shooting Competition

1. Eligibility

- Open to participants aged 21 years and older.
- Employees of the event organisers are not eligible to win the prize.

2. Competition Format

- The competition format, rules of shooting, and scoring will be disclosed on the day of the event and are subject to change at the discretion of the organisers for safety or fairness.
- Safety is non-negotiable. Any breach of range rules, misuse of equipment, or unsafe behaviour will result in immediate disqualification and ejection from the event.

3. Winner Selection

- The participant with the highest score at the end of the competition will be declared the winner.
- In the event of a tie, a shoot-off will determine the winner.

4. Prize

- The winner will receive use of a **D-Max Isuzu vehicle** for a period of **six (6) months**.
- The vehicle remains the property of the provider and is **loaned** subject to strict **internal vetting criteria**, including (but not limited to):
 - Valid full driver's licence.
 - Clean driving history (minor offences may be considered at Isuzu's discretion).
 - The **winner must** insure this vehicle on a fully comprehensive basis during the **entire loan period**.
 - Agreement to terms of a separate vehicle loan agreement, including return condition and usage limits (e.g., mileage cap, no commercial use, etc.).
 - Winners will receive the vehicle once vetting process has been carried out by Isuzu and once there is a vehicle available for loan.

5. Internal Vetting

- Vetting will be conducted **post-event** and before the vehicle is handed over.

- If the winner fails to meet the vetting criteria, the prize will be **forfeited**, and the organisers reserve the right to award the prize to the runner-up (subject to the same vetting process).
- There is **no cash alternative** to the prize.
- Vetting is Isuzu's responsibility, and Isuzu's decision is final.

6. General Conditions

- The organisers reserve the right to:
 - Modify, postpone, or cancel the event due to unforeseen circumstances.
 - Disqualify any participant suspected of cheating, unsportsmanlike behaviour, or breach of these terms.
- By entering, participants agree to have their name, score, and image used for promotional purposes related to the event and future events, without additional compensation.

7. Liability Waiver

- Participants acknowledge and assume all risks associated with clay pigeon shooting and participation in the event.
- The organisers, sponsors, and venue accept no liability for injury, loss, or damage to person or property except as required by law.

8. Governing Law

- These terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
